Here, the history begins with the 1930s, however, and the majority of the examples are from current times, all

presumably previously published in ELLE DECOR magazine. But traditional styles are well represented with chic examples such as an office pavillion decorated by Francois-Joseph Graff for Pierre Berge -- a good arguement for working at home. While it is not an instructive book on style as such, careful study of the photos should provide inspiration to all interested in interior design, regardless of budget.

Compiled by the editors of Elle Decor, the definitive voice of good taste, this rich collection of interiors from eclectic and eccentric to classic chic can inspire every reader looking for a little *je ne sais quoi* for their home.
